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V10 Build 2 Installation Notes

Framework Patch

Note the below points prior to installing V10 Build 2:

- **Upgrading an existing site to V10 Build 2** – Install the V10 Framework Patch first, then install v10 Build 2.
- **Clean installation of V10 Build 2** – Install the latest V10 Framework, then install v10 Build 2.

Now Book It Gift Card License

- **Now Book It Gift Cards require license** – If utilising Now Book It Gift Cards with the Now Book It Reservation Interface, a new module "NowBookIt Gift Cards" will need to be purchased/enabled for each POS Terminal prior to upgrading to v10 Build 2. More information is [listed here](#).

eCommerce

IP-8117 – eCommerce – Option to Limit Queued Order Processing

This functionality adds a new option to specify the number of seconds that each order should be processed.

This is achieved by enabling a new option "Limit Order Processing Rate – One Order every X seconds"; X being the number of seconds to process each order.

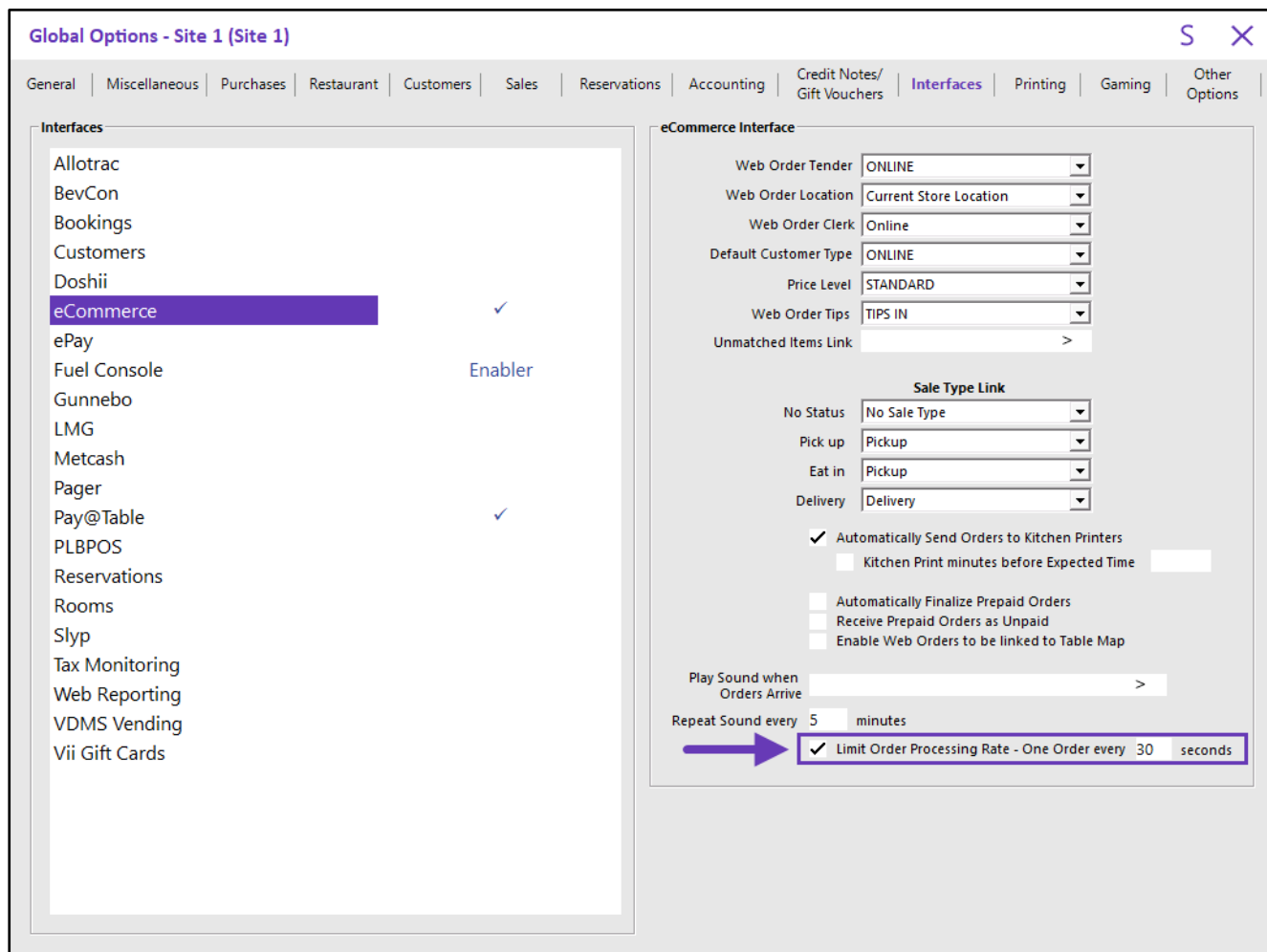
This option will apply to the number of orders that are printed to the Kitchen Printers, Sent to Ideal Kitchen Monitor and displayed in the Web Orders at the top of the POS Screen.

This function can be used in conjunction with web store wait times to manage event crowds.

To configure this functionality, go to: Back Office > Setup > Global Options > Interfaces > eCommerce.

Enable the checkbox "Limit Order Processing Rate – One Order every X seconds".

Enter the number of seconds to limit per order.

Metcash Integration

IP-8123 – Metcash Promotions – Promotion Types link to Promotion Groups

This functionality introduces the ability to create Metcash Promotion Types and link them to Idealpos Promotion Groups, with the option to specify if the Metcash Promotion Type is applicable to Loyalty members.

A Metcash Host contains Promotions which are associated with Promotion Types defined in the Host.

When the Metcash Host is processed, Promotion Types in the Host will be checked against the Promotion Types that exist in Idealpos.

- If the Promotion Type(s) exist in Idealpos, the resulting Promotions from the Promotion Types will be linked to their respective Promotion Groups.
- If the Promotion Type(s) do not exist in Idealpos, they will be created automatically, and the resulting Promotions will be linked to the Default Promotion Group configured in Global Options > Interfaces > Metcash > Promotion Group.
If there is no Promotion Group specified in Global Options, then the first Promotion Group (e.g. Promotions) will be used.

Note – If a Promotion Type does not exist and Idealpos creates the Promotion Type automatically when processing the Host, it will not automatically link that Promotion Type to the Promotion Group specified in Global Options!

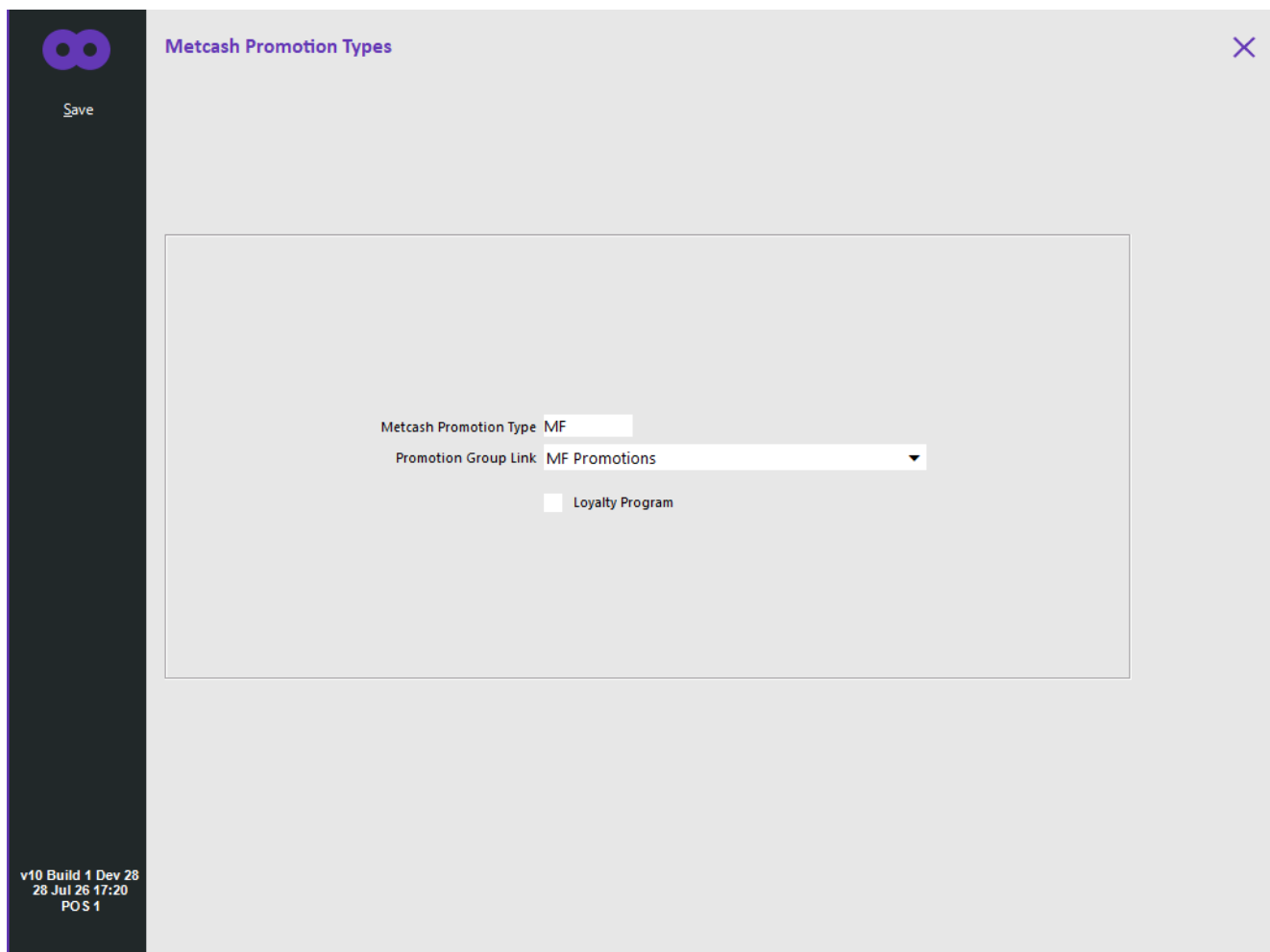
To configure and use this functionality, go to: Back Office > Utilities > Metcash > Promotion Types > Add.

- **Metcash Promotion Type:** Enter the Metcash Promotion Type Code as it appears in the Metcash Host (e.g. MF).
- **Promotion Group Link:** Select a Promotion Group from the dropdown box. Promotion Groups can be created via Back Office > File > Sales > Promotions > Promotion Groups.
- **Loyalty Program:** Enable this checkbox if the Promotions for this Promotion Type are only applicable to the Loyalty Program. When this option is enabled, the resulting Promotions will have their Metcash Loyalty Program checkbox enabled in the Promotion Advanced tab.

Press "Save" to create the Promotion Type.

Repeat the process for each Promotion Type as required.

Note that changing a Promotion Group Link or Loyalty Program checkbox will only affect any new Promotions that are created via a Host. If the Promotions have already been created via a Host, re-processing the same Host will update the existing Promotions as per the Promotion Group Link/Loyalty Program checkbox.



If required, it may also be beneficial to configure a Default Promotion Group as outlined in [IP-8124 – Metcash Promotions – Default Promotion Group](#). This will ensure that Promotions are linked to a specified Promotion Group if their Promotion Type does not exist in Idealpos. If a Promotion Group is not configured in Global Options, the first Promotion Group (e.g. Promotions) will be used.

After the Promotion Types have been created, process a Metcash Host which contains the Promotion Types. The Metcash Host can be processed by going to: Back Office > Utilities > Metcash > Import Files > Import. After the Host has been imported, the Promotions will be linked to their Promotion Group as per the Metcash Promotion Type linking process performed above.

Go to: Back Office > File > Sales > Promotions > Promotions.

The Group column will show the Promotion Group that the Promotions are linked to as shown in the example below:

IP-8124 – Metcash Promotions – Default Promotion Group

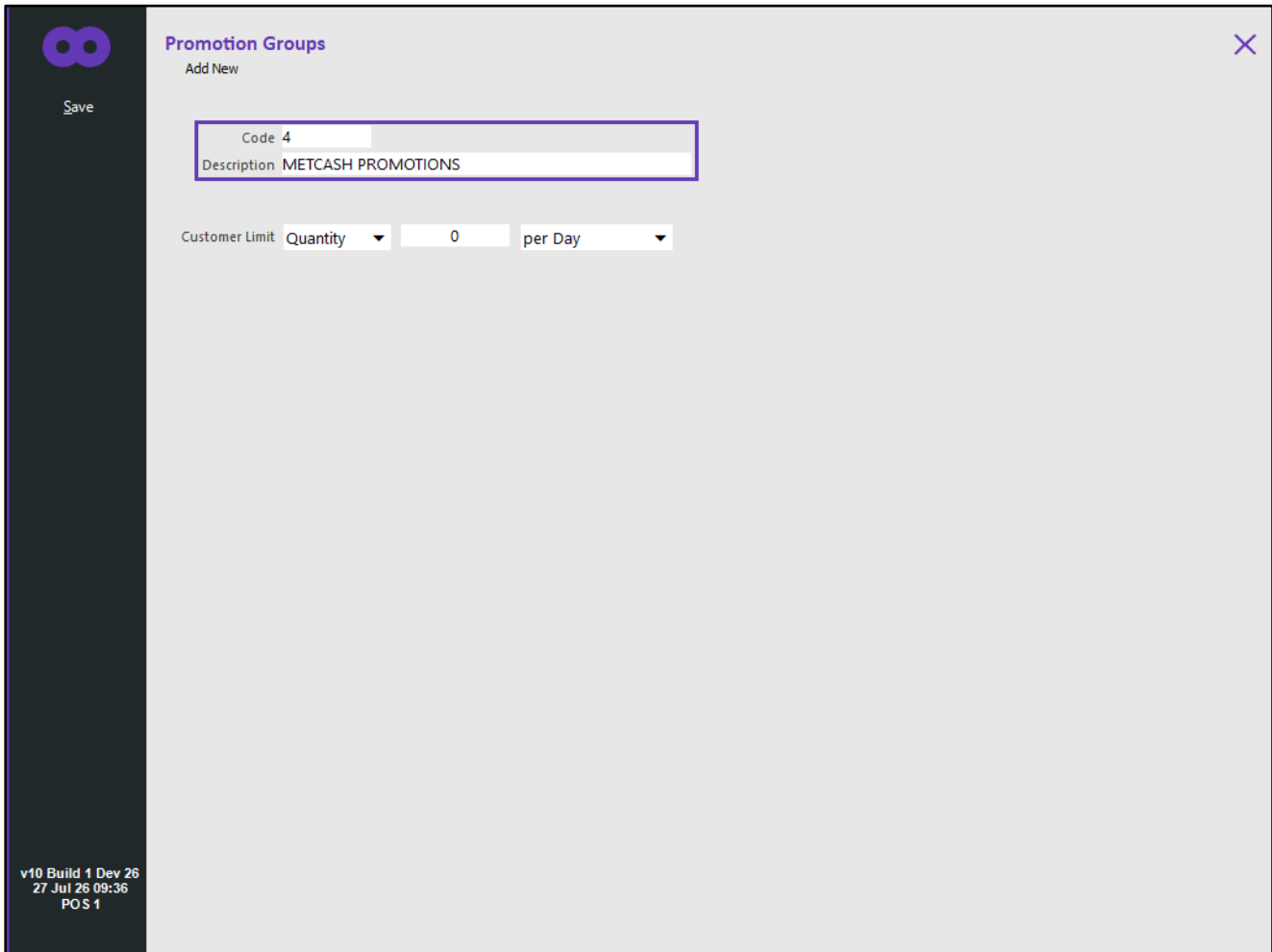
This functionality introduces the ability to specify a Default Promotion Group for any new Promotions that are created from a Metcash Host File.

This can be used to separate Metcash Hosted Promotions from the Promotions created by the site.

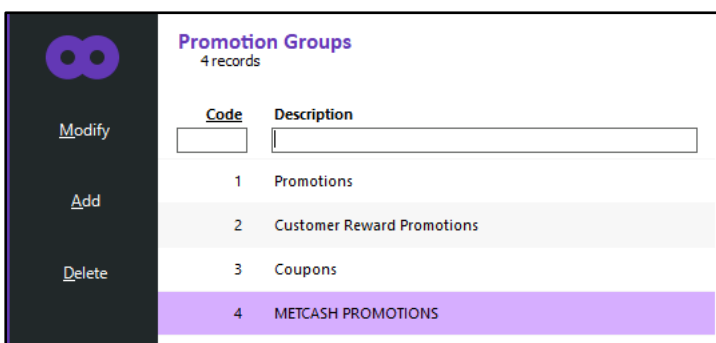
To configure this functionality, go to: Back Office > File > Sales > Promotions > Promotion Groups.

If there is an existing Promotion Group that is suitable for this functionality, take note of the Promotion Group Code.

Alternatively, press the "Add" button on the top-left corner of the Promotion Groups window to create a new Promotion Group; take note of the Promotion Group Code when creating a new Promotion Group.



After pressing "Save", the new Promotion Group will appear in the list of Promotion Groups.

Click the dropdown box at the top of the window and select the Promotion Group Name (e.g. METCASH PROMOTIONS).

The Promotions window will only display Promotions that are linked to the selected Promotion Group Name.

IP-8125 – Metcash Promotions – POS Range Functionality

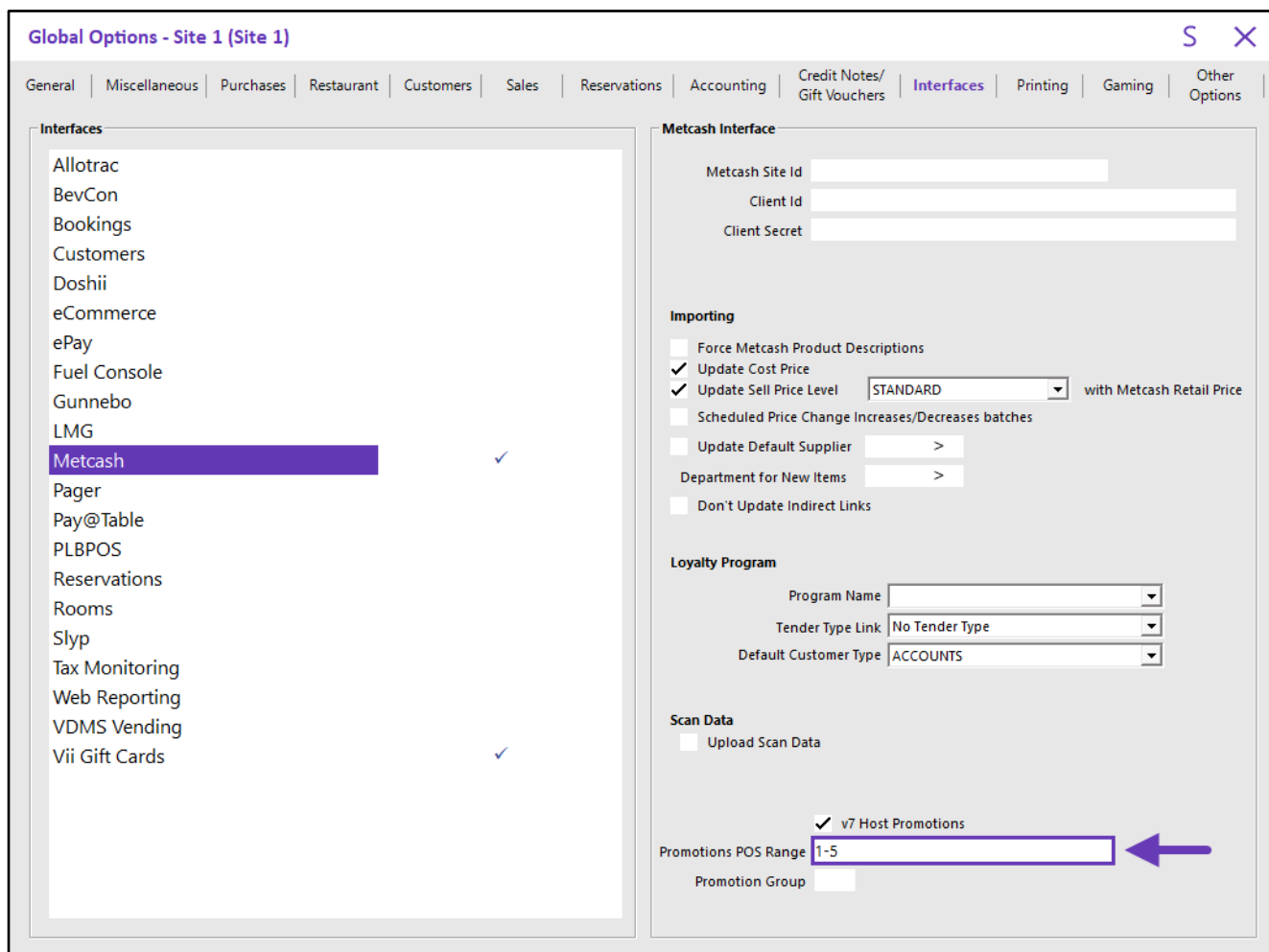
This functionality introduces the ability to limit which POS Terminals can trigger Promotions created from a Metcash Host. When a POS Range value is not specified, Metcash Host Promotions can be triggered at any POS Terminal. When a POS Range value is specified, only the POS Terminal Numbers that fall within the specified range will be able to trigger Promotions that are created from a Metcash Host.

To configure and use this functionality, go to: Back Office > Setup > Global Options > Interfaces > Metcash.

Enter a POS Range into the “Promotions POS Range” field.

E.g. Entering 1-5 into the Promotions POS Range field will restrict Promotions created from Metcash Hosts to only apply to POS Terminals that fall within the specified range.

Note – The value specified in this field will only apply to new Promotions that are created from processing Metcash Hosts after this setting has been configured. Existing Promotions will not be modified (unless a previously processed Host File that contained Promotions is re-processed again which will trigger existing Promotions to be updated as per the POS Range field).

Close the Global Options window to save changes.

The next time a Metcash Host that contains Promotions is processed (via Back Office > Utilities > Metcash > Import Files), those Promotions will have their POS Field populated with the POS Range, thereby restricting them to only trigger at the POS Terminals that fall within the specified POS Range.

Go to: Back Office > File > Sales > Promotions > Promotions > Select a Metcash Promotion > Modify.

The POS field is populated as per the POS Range configured above.

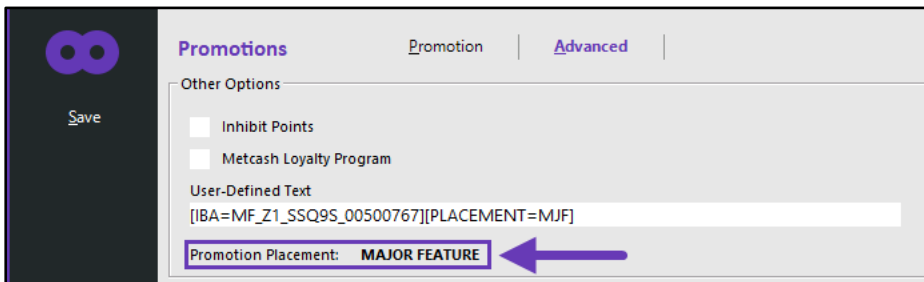

IP-8171 – Metcash – Show Promotion Placement Descriptor on Promotions Screen

This functionality adds the Promotion Placement Descriptor to the Promotions Screen (Advanced tab of a Promotion). When a Metcash Host is processed that contains Promotions, the Promotions will typically have a Promotion Placement Code (e.g. MJF for Major Feature, INS for Instore, etc.). When a Host File containing Metcash Promotions with Promotion Placement Codes is processed into Idealpos, the resulting Promotions in Idealpos will show the Promotion Placement Descriptor in the Promotion Advanced Tab. There is no additional configuration required for this functionality. Note that the Promotion Placement Descriptor will only show for Hosted Promotions that have been imported from a Host File after updating to Idealpos v10 Build 2 (existing Promotions that were previously imported with an older build of Idealpos will not show the Promotion Placement Descriptor on the Promotions screen).

To use this functionality, import a Metcash Host File that contains Promotions.
Go to: Back Office > Utilities > Metcash > Import Files > Import a Host.

After the host has been imported, go to: Back Office > File > Sales > Promotions > Promotions.
Select a Promotion > Modify.
The Advanced tab of the Promotion will display the Promotion Placement Descriptor.

POS Screen

IP-402 – Print Group Shift Function – Descriptor shows in POS Screen

This functionality will display the Print Group Shift Descriptor (e.g. ENTRÉE, MAINS, etc.) next to the Stock Item name on the POS Screen when the Print Group Shift function is used to change the Print Group during a sale (e.g. BEEF <MAIN>).

Previously, the Print Group Code would appear on the POS Screen next to the Item Description when the Print Group Shift function was used (e.g. BEEF ^2).

There is no additional configuration required to toggle between the Print Group Shift Code or Print Group Shift Descriptor from appearing.

After updating to this build of Idealpos v10, the Print Group Descriptor will be displayed next to a Stock Item on the POS Screen when using the Print Group Shift function.

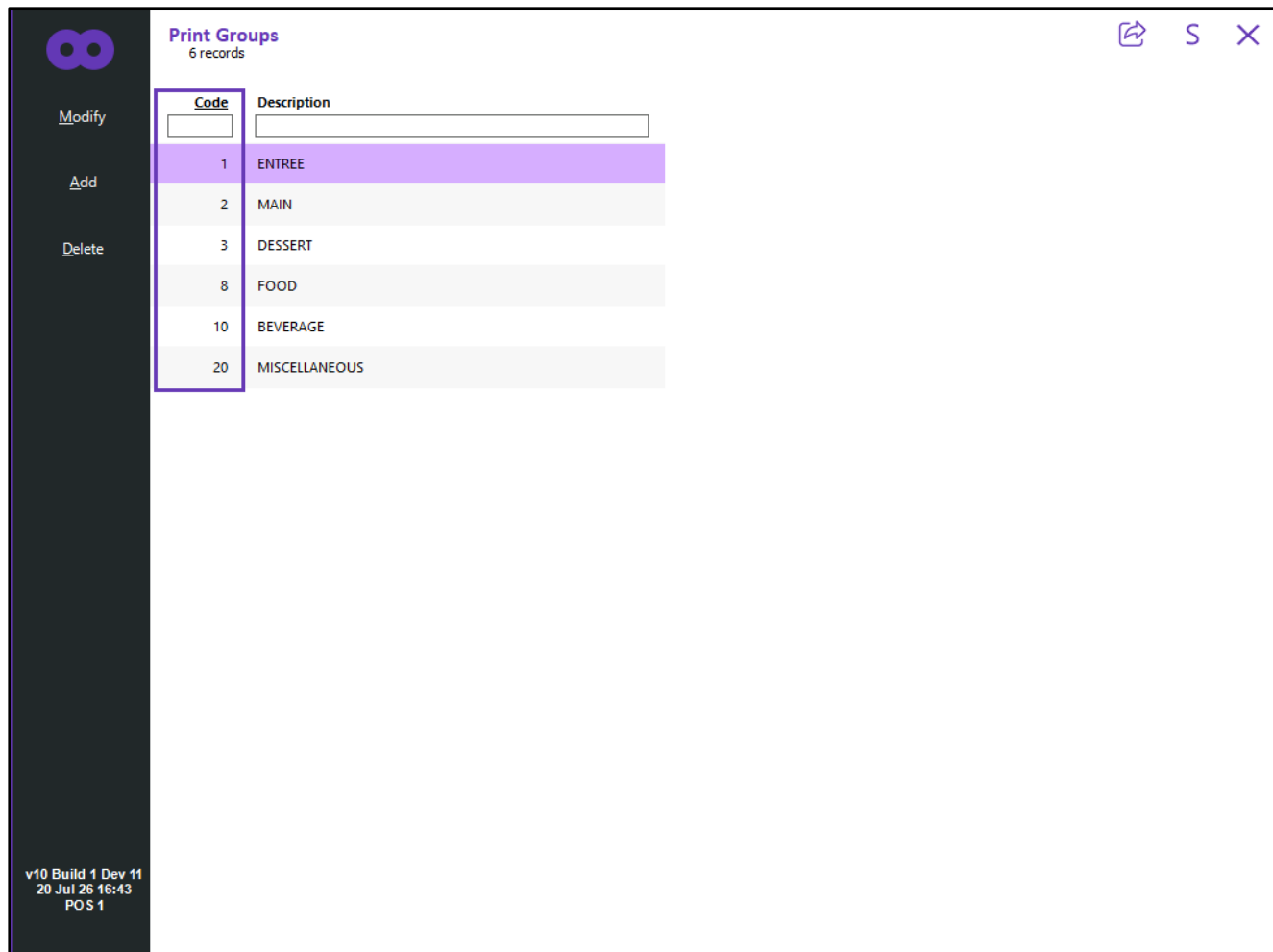
To configure/use Print Group Shift functionality, go to:

Back Office > Setup > Restaurant > Print Groups.

Ensure that the Print Group(s) required exist.

If necessary, create new Print Groups as required.

When creating Print Groups, note the Print Group Code which appears on the left-hand side of the Print Groups window. The Print Group Code will be required when setting up a POS Screen Button for the Print Group.

To setup Print Group Shift buttons, go to:

Back Office > Setup > POS Screen > POS Screen Setup > Select a Layout > Buttons.

Create a button for each Print Group Shift that is required.

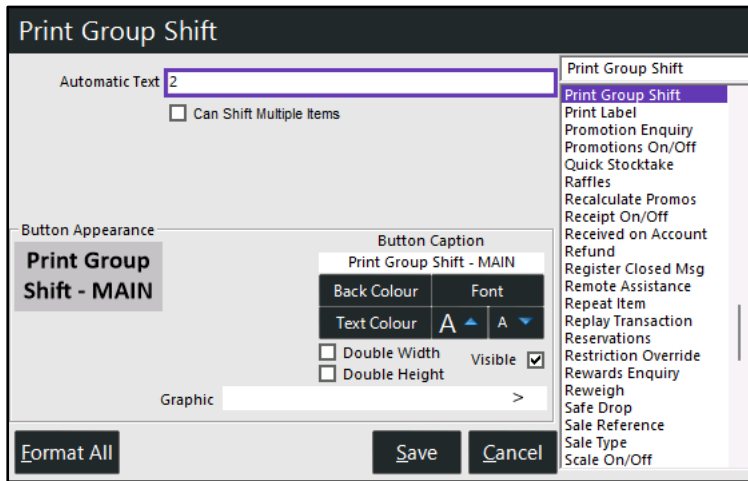
E.g. Print Group Shift – MAIN

Print Group Shift – ENTRÉE

Etc.

- Function: Print Group Shift
- Automatic Text: Enter the Print Group Code
- Can Shift Multiple Items: Unchecked

When the “Can Shift Multiple Items” option is enabled, pressing the Print Group Shift button will trigger all the items that have been added to be shifted to the Print Group configured for the Print Group Shift button.



After creating the buttons required for each Print Group Shift, close the POS Screen Layout window.

Go to: POS Screen.

Add Stock Item(s) to the sale.

Select a Stock Item in the sale window > Press the Print Group Shift button.

The Stock Item's Print Group will be shifted using the Print Group configured on the button.

The Print Group Descriptor will appear next to the Stock Item's Description.

After pressing the Print Group Shift button, the Stock Item's Print Group Descriptor will appear next to the Item Description in the sale window.

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IP-8134 – Print Label Function – POS Screen Function to send current Line to Zebra Label

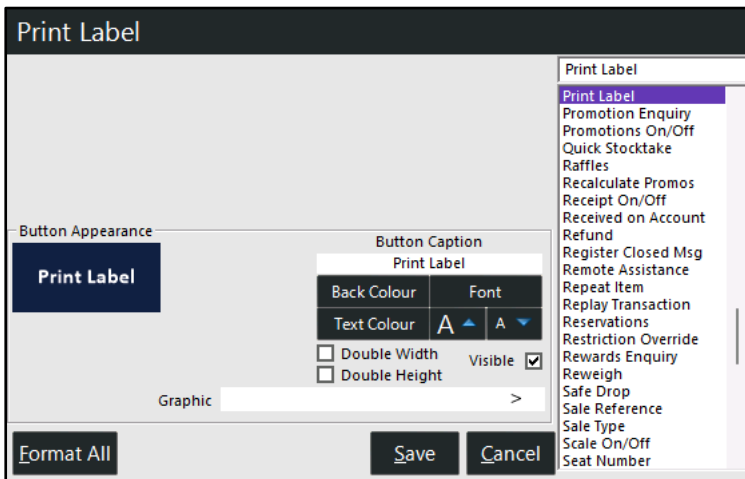
This functionality introduces the ability to send the current line on the POS Screen to a Zebra Label printer. The printed label will contain the Audit Number, Date, Weight of the Stock Item, Amount per unit (e.g. kg/g/etc.), Description of the Stock Item and the Dollar value.

To configure this functionality, go to:

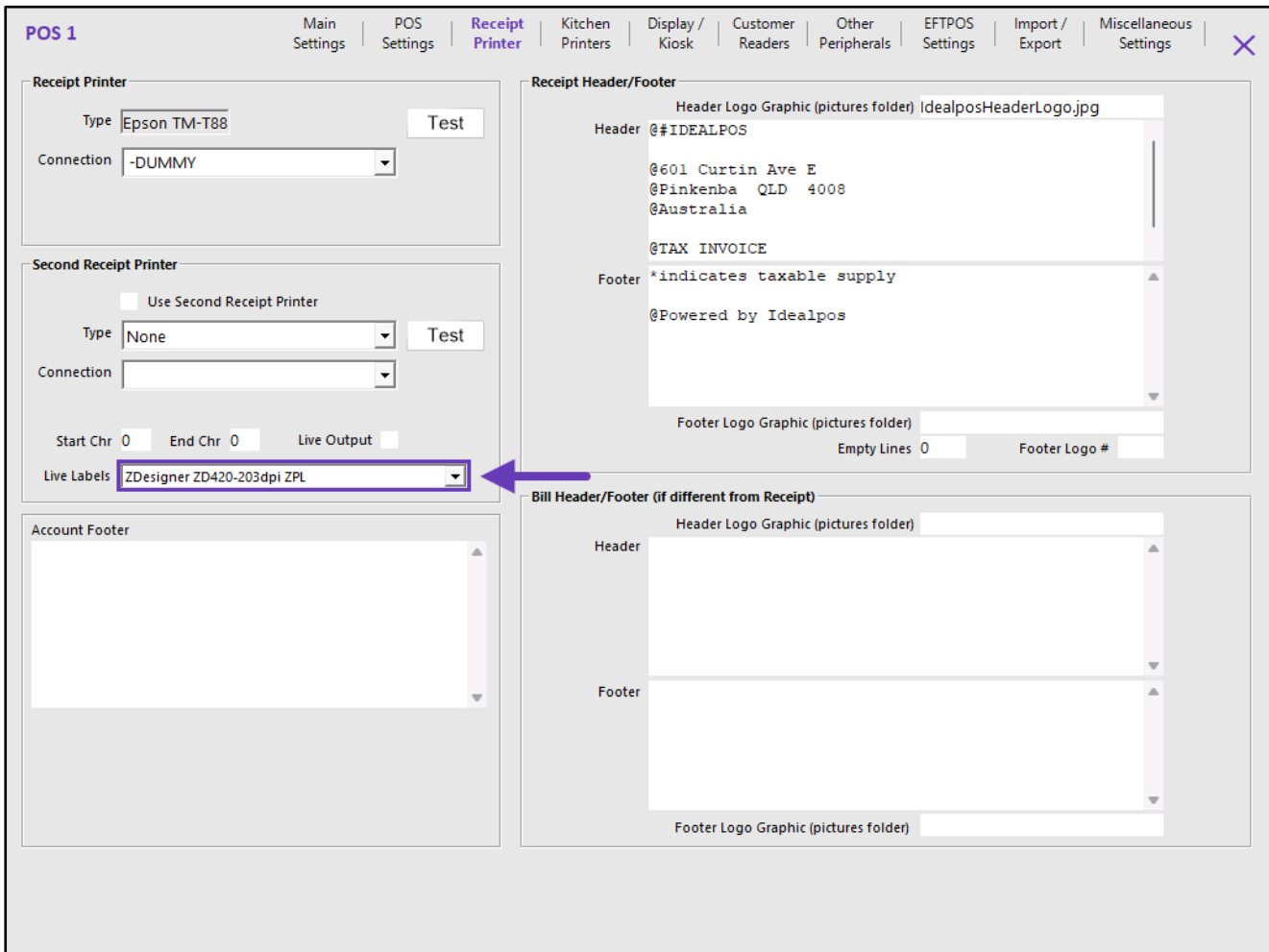

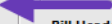

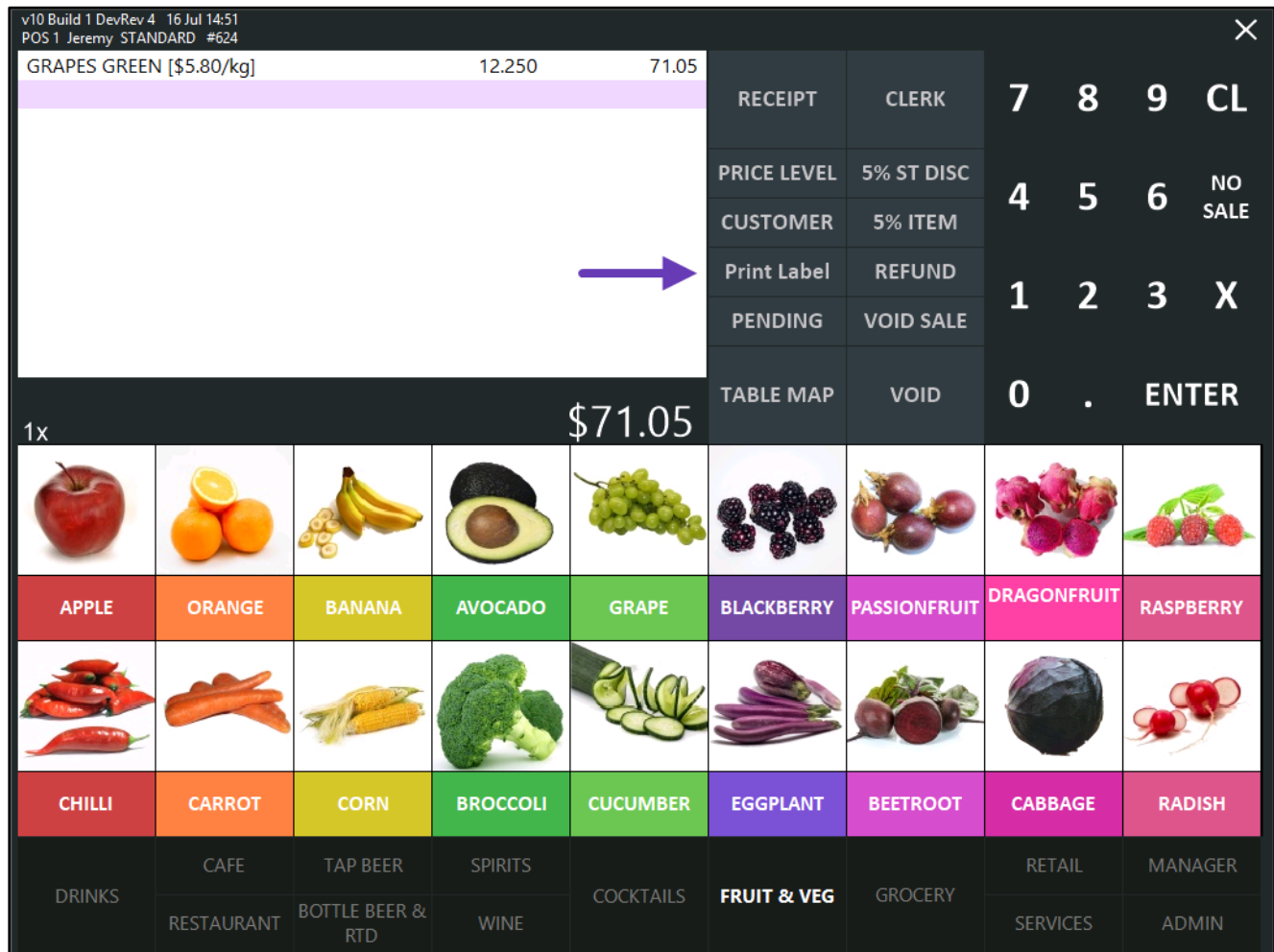

When choosing which Stock Item will have a label printed to the Zebra label, there are two methods:

When a Stock Item isn't highlighted in the sale window and the Print Label button is pressed, Idealpos will print a label to the Zebra Label printer for the last Stock Item in the sale.

When a Stock Item is selected in the sale window and the Print Label button is pressed, Idealpos will print a label to the Zebra Label printer for the currently selected Stock Item in the sale.



After pressing the "Print Label" button, a label will be printed to the Zebra Label printer.



IP-8141 – Table Details – Group by Print Group Shift

This functionality adds support for Grouping by Print Group Shift on the Table Details screen.

Prior to this change, Stock Items were grouped by their original Print Groups in the Table Details screen even when the Print Group Shift function was used to change their Print Group.

When using the Print Group Shift function to change a Stock Item's Print Group, the items will now be grouped by their Shifted Print Group.

Once the Print Group Shift buttons have been setup as outlined in IP-402, follow the below steps to use this functionality on the Table Details screen.

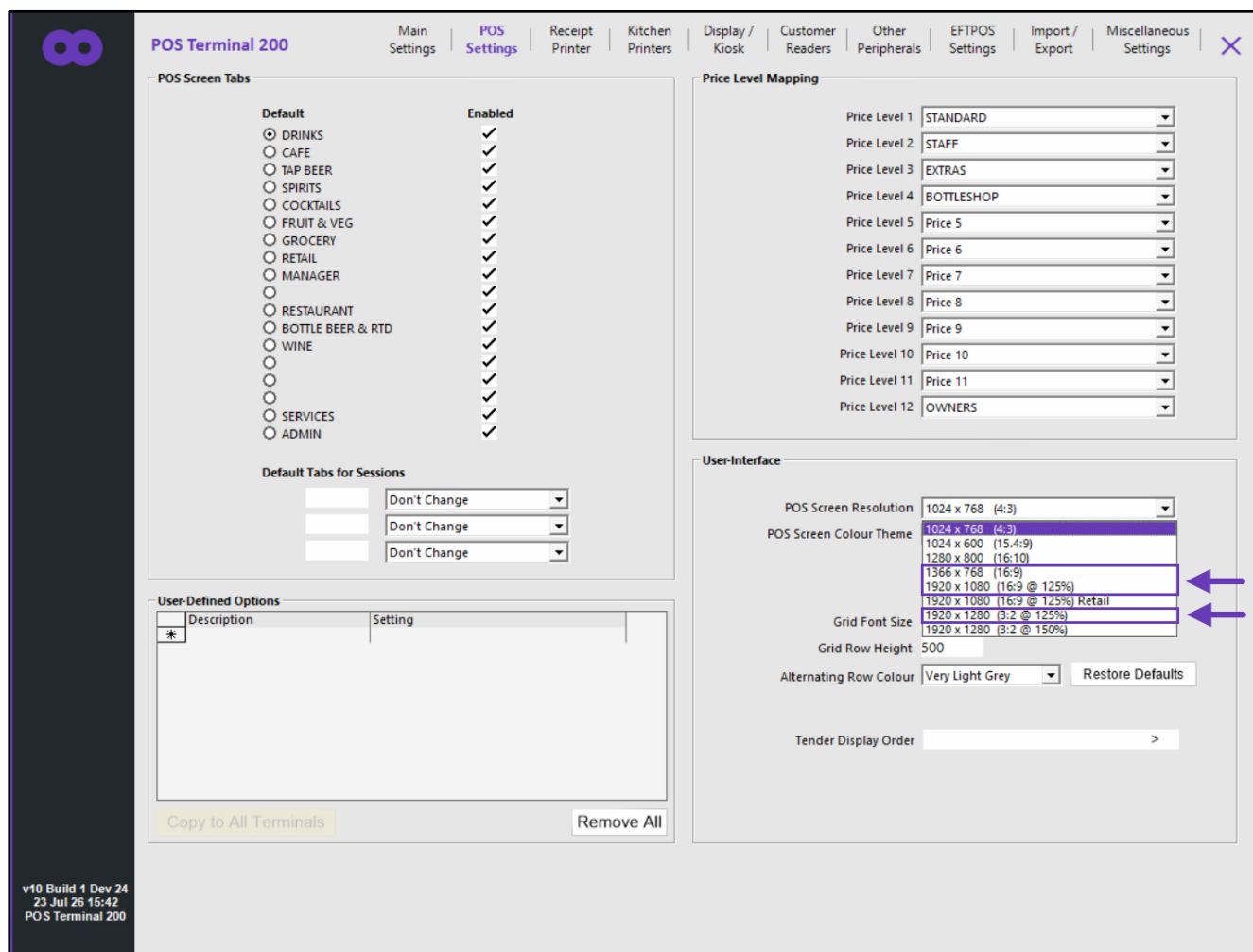
