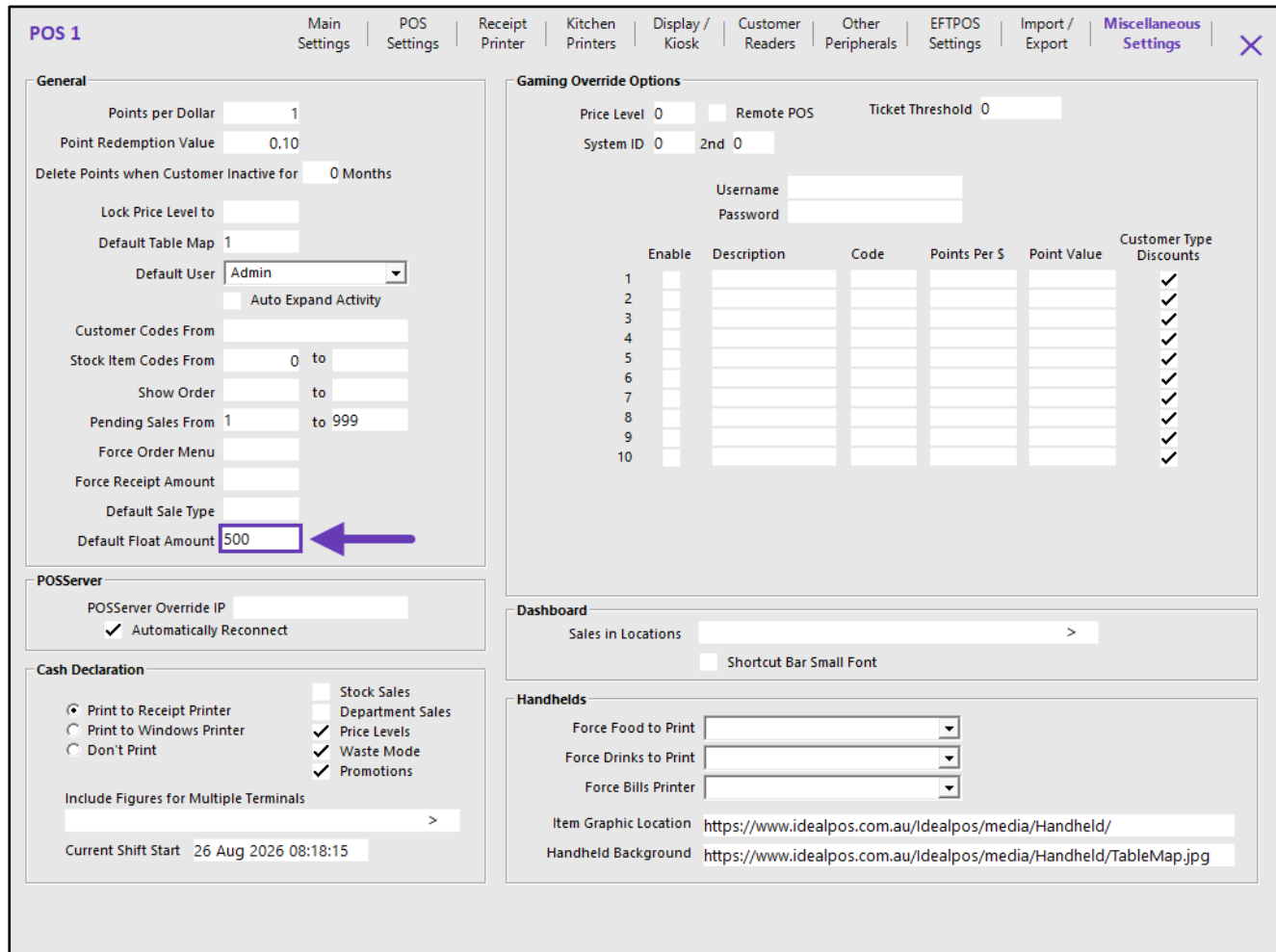
This functionality introduces the ability to set a Default Float Entry Amount.

This can be utilised when a venue always fills the float with the same cash amount, removing the need for the Clerk to manually enter the amount each time.

To configure and use this functionality, go to:

Back Office > Setup > POS Terminals > Select a POS Terminal > Modify > Miscellaneous Settings.

Enter the desired amount into the Default Float Amount field.

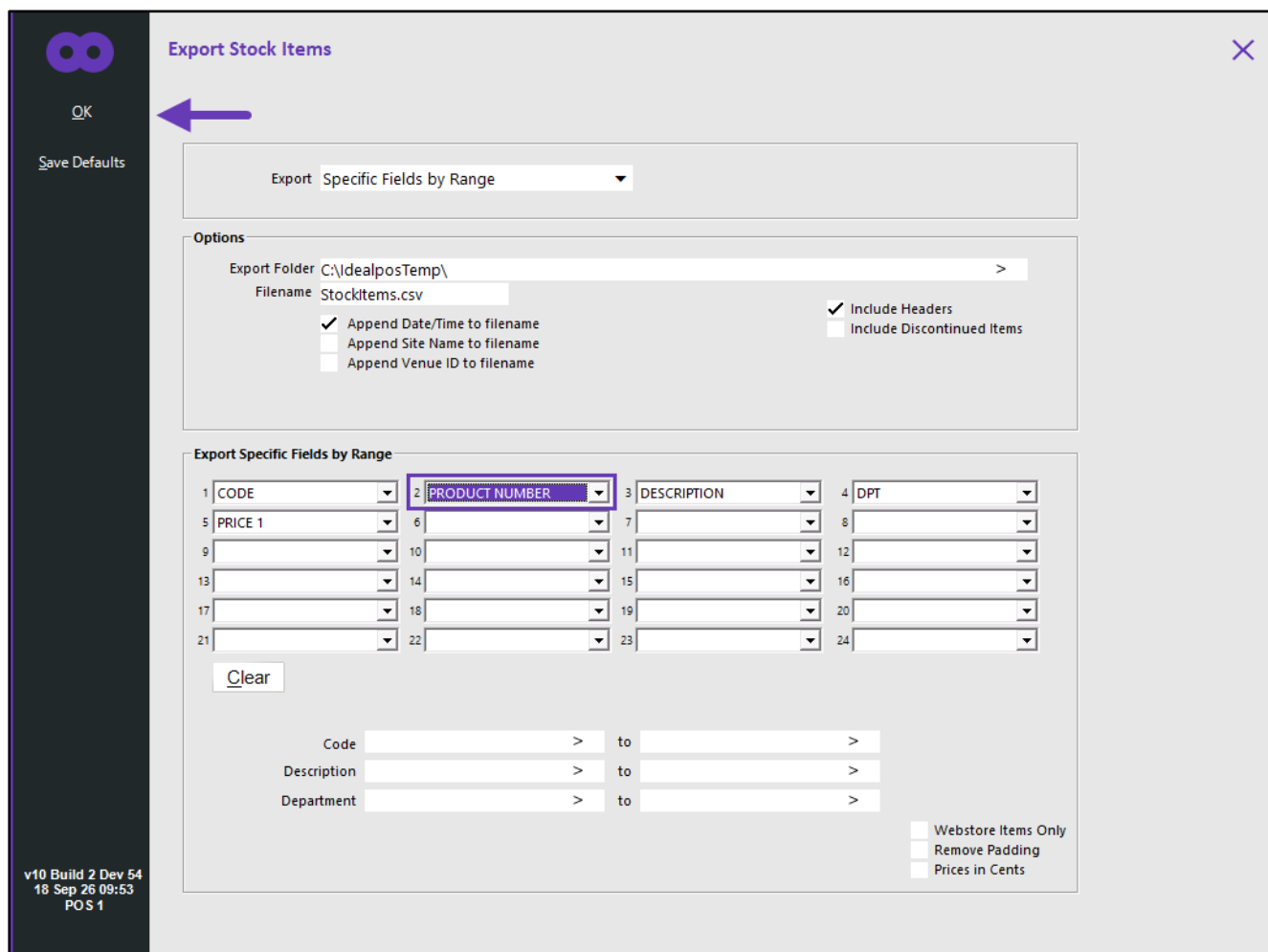
Export/Import Data

IP-8269 – Stock Items Export – Support for Product Number field

This functionality introduces the ability to export the Product Number field in the Stock Items Export. The Product Number is stored in the National Product Number field in the Stock Item Advanced tab. If WEX Fuel Cards are enabled with Quest EFTPOS, the National Product Number field in the Stock Item Advanced tab appears as Quest Product Number; the Quest Product Number will be exported when exporting the Product Number.

To use this functionality, go to: Back Office > Utilities > Export Data > Stock Items > Export Specific Fields by Range. The Product Number field is also available when using the Automatic Export Format.

In one of the 24 dropdown boxes under Export Specific Fields by Range, select "PRODUCT NUMBER". Also ensure that the Export Folder, Filename and other options are toggled as required. Press "OK" to commence the Export.

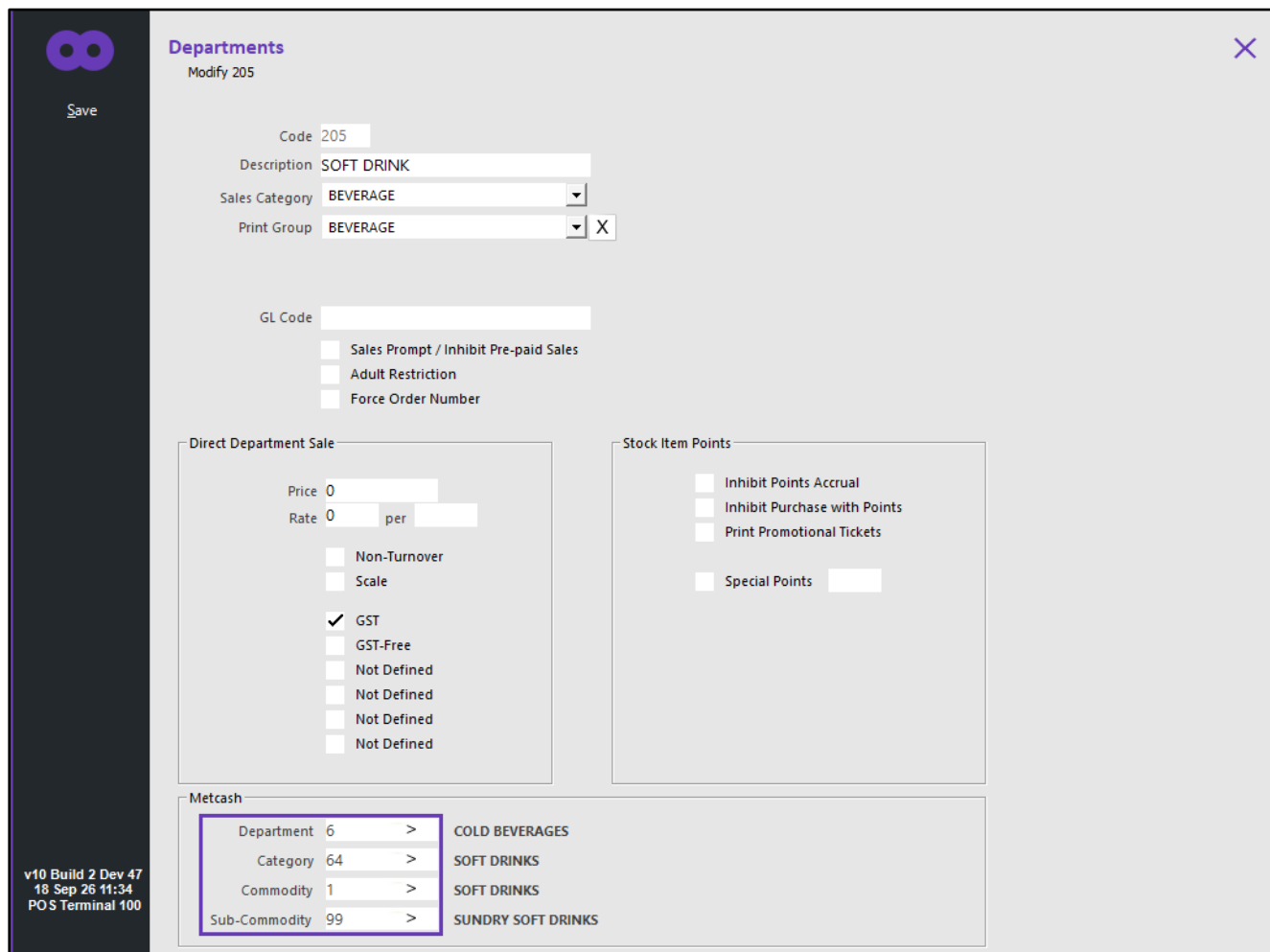

IP-8260 – Metcash – Export/Import Departments – Support for Metcash Linking Fields

This functionality adds support for Metcash Linking Fields when Exporting or Importing Departments. This functionality only works when the Metcash Basic or Metcash Advanced module is enabled in the Licence Gateway. This functionality is only for importing Departments and linking them to Metcash MSC fields using existing Metcash MSC data that has been previously imported via a Metcash Host.

This functionality will not import the actual Metcash MSC data (e.g. the Metcash Departments, Metcash Categories, Metcash Commodities, Metcash Sub-Commodities) as this is done via the Metcash Host File Import.

The Metcash Linking Fields are the Department, Category, Commodity and Sub-Commodity fields that appear in the Metcash section when modifying a Department via Back Office > File > Sales > Departments > Select a Department > Modify.

When using the Import Departments functionality to import Metcash Linking Fields, use the following headers, noting that **all 4 fields must be included** in the import file.

MetcashDepartment, MetcashCategory, MetcashCommodity, MetcashSubCommodity

When specifying the Metcash Linking Fields in an import file, note that the Metcash MSC data must be a valid combination.

E.g. When importing the data, ensure that the MetcashSubCommodity is associated with the MetcashCommodity which is associated with the MetcashCategory which is associated with the MetcashDepartment.

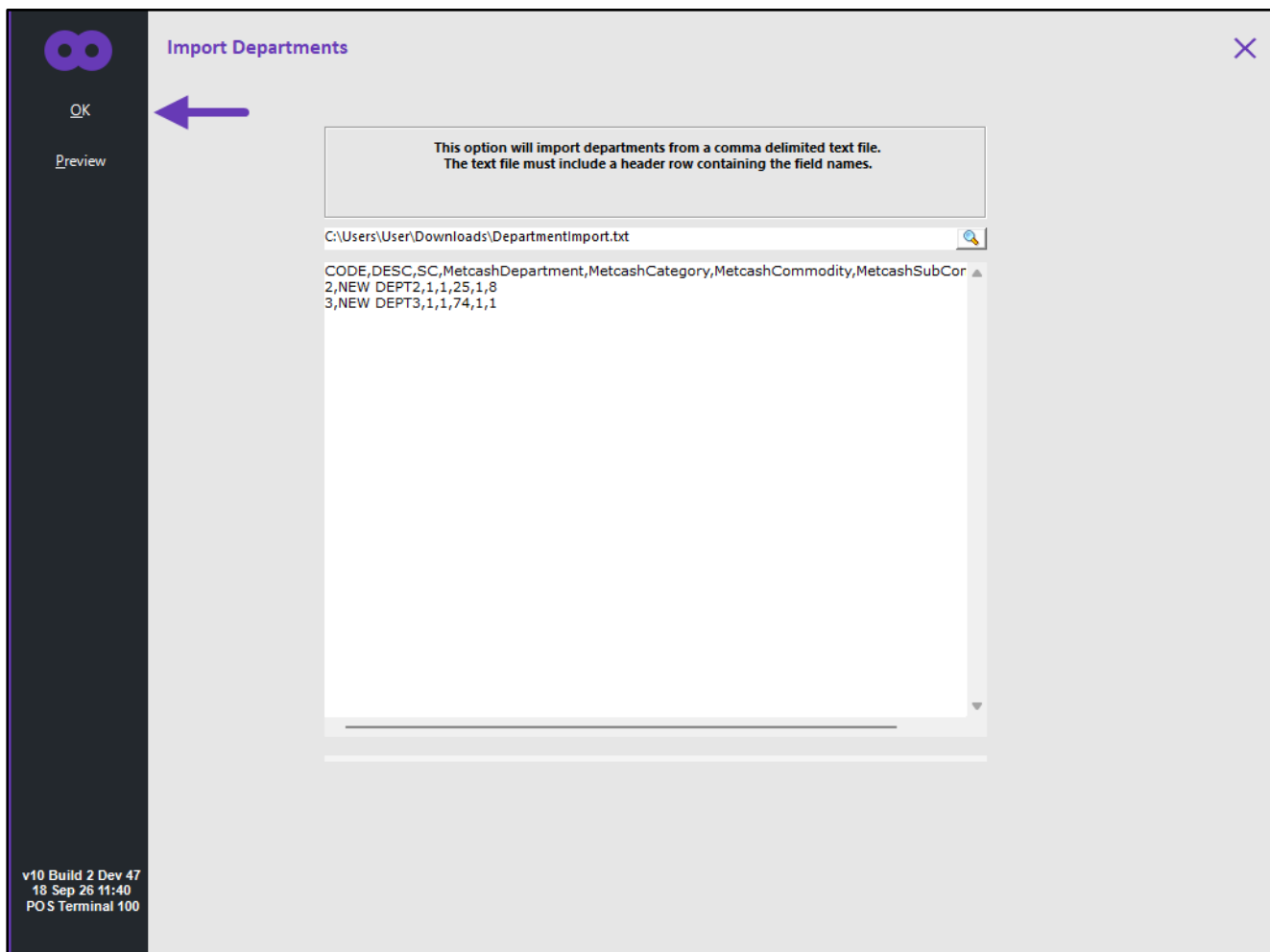

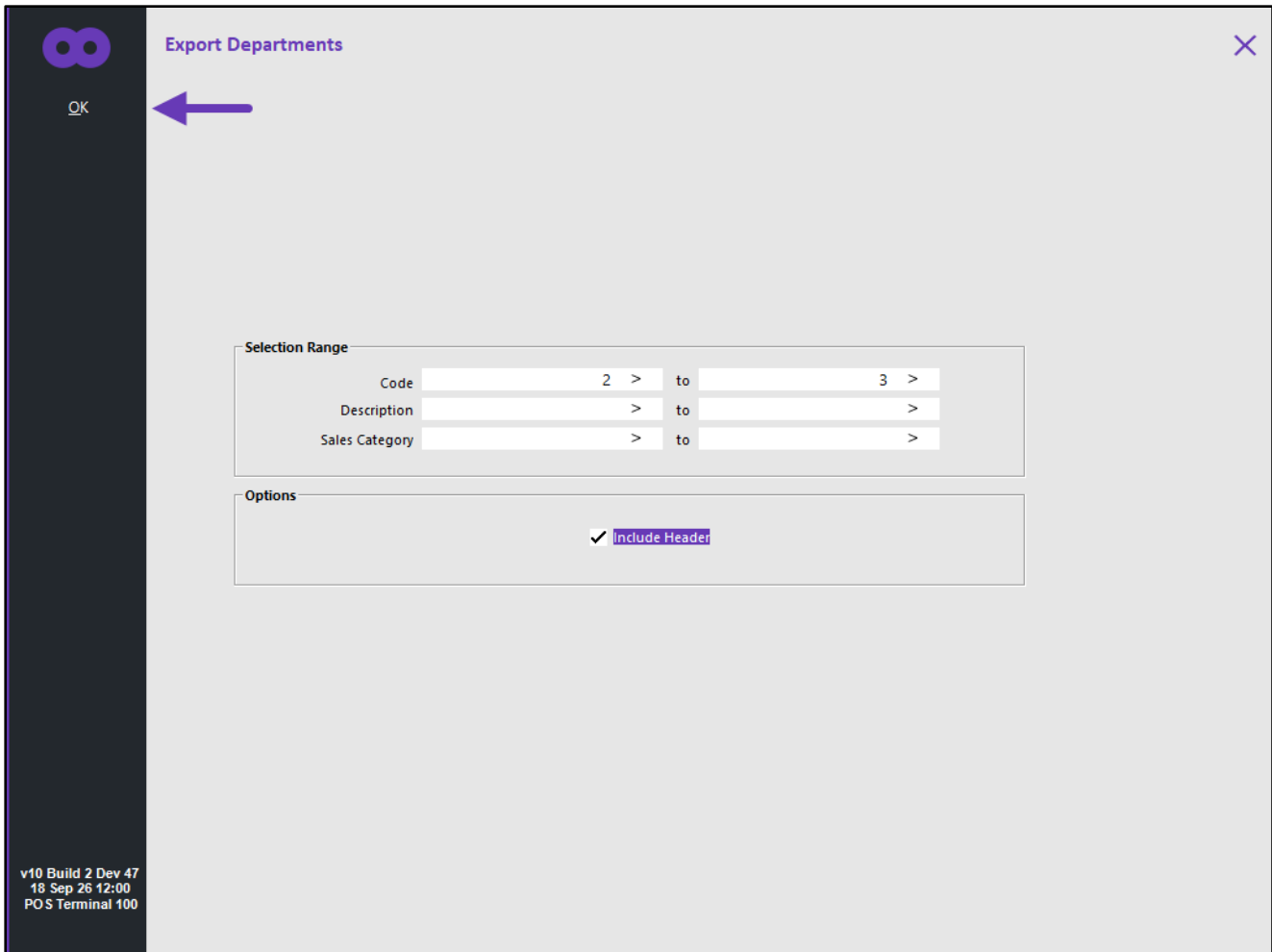

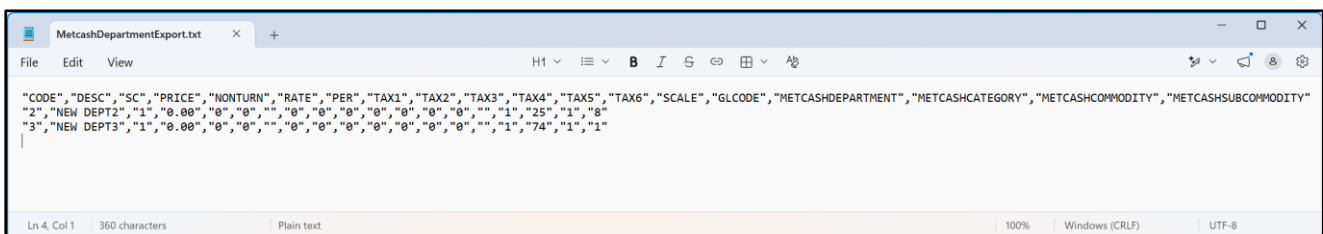

Gaming

IP-8142 – Gaming Points Redemptions – Support Non-Discounted Buckets and Discounted Buckets

This functionality adds support for Non-Discounted Buckets and Discounted Buckets when performing Gaming Points Redemptions.

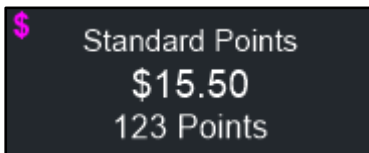

Part of this change allows the full amount to be paid on the chosen bucket which is non-discounted.

As multiple amounts can be displayed and selecting POINTS on the Tender Grid with the amount to pay (typically the entire sale is paid with points, or the remaining Points balance), the title of the bucket choosing form has been changed to "Choose Point Type".

In addition, the buckets that will get the automatic discount will display a small pink symbol on the top left.



Metcash Integration

IP-8216 – Metcash Host – Support for HO/SM modules

This functionality adds support for Metcash Host functionality to be used with Head Office/Site Management. This functionality is currently intended to have Metcash Scan Data handled across a group with Head Office/Site Management.

E.g.

At Head Office, Import the Metcash Host > link Metcash Products to Idealpos Stock Items either automatically, manually and via Department linking.

When creating new Idealpos Stock Items from the Metcash Products, the new Stock Items will contain the MSC data > Stock Items can then be copied from the base items to the Sites > Stock Items are created at the Site Management Terminals with MSC data.

MSC data for Stock Items will be sent back to Metcash as the items are sold.

As part of this functionality, the Metcash Linking Fields (Metcash Department, Metcash Category, Metcash Commodity, Metcash Sub-Commodity) are also correctly populated at the Head Office and the Site Management Terminals.

Pocket Pad

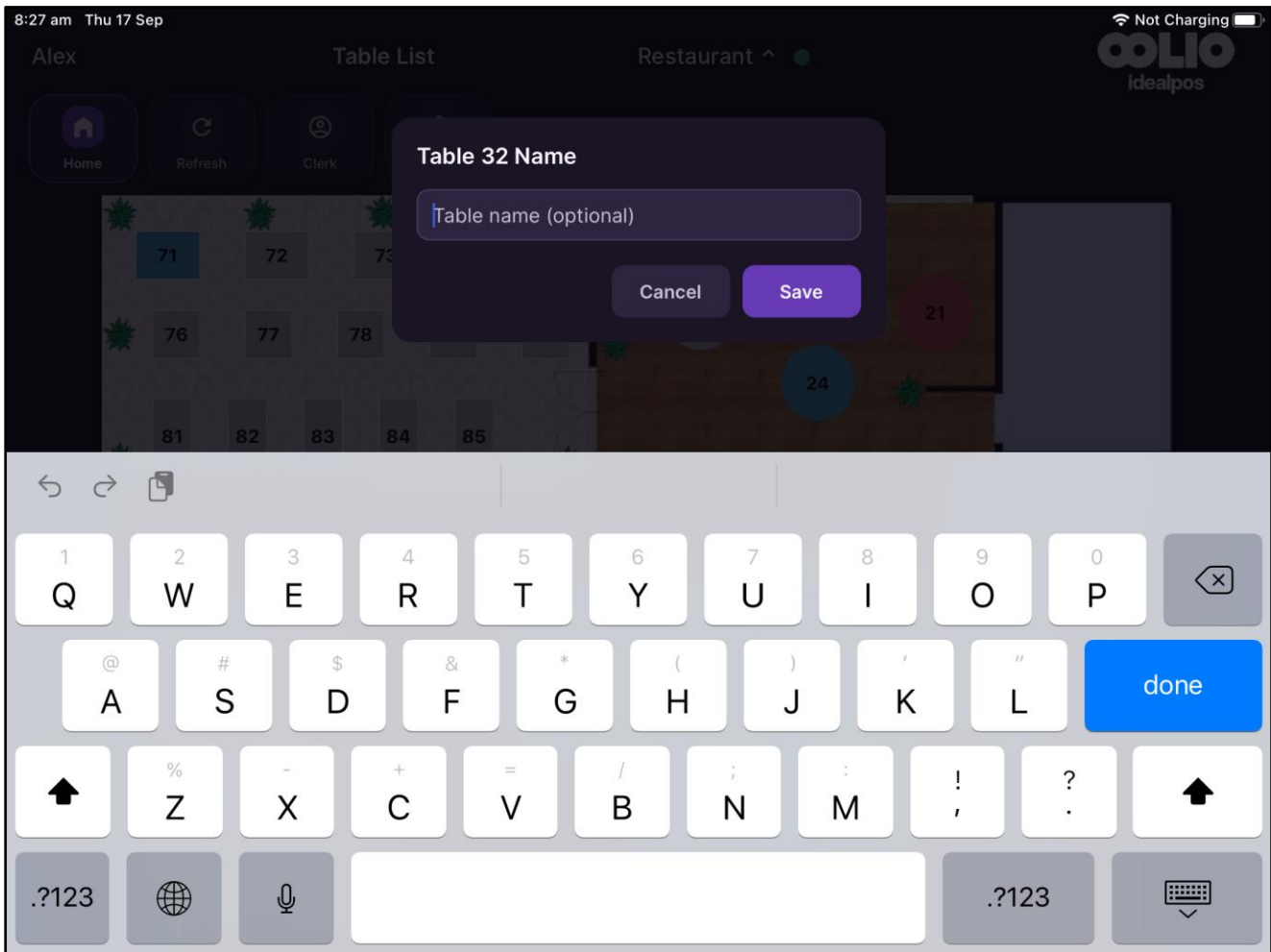

This functionality adds support for Names on Tables in Pocket Pad.

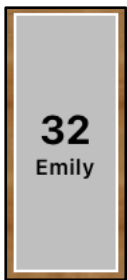
Pocket Pad can now display the Name that has been set on a Table as well as being able to set or modify a Table Name.

To utilise this functionality, Pocket Pad v3.1.9 or higher is required.

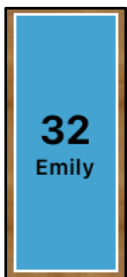
To set a Table Name in Pocket Pad, long-press on a Table > The Table Name prompt appears > Enter a Name.



The entered name is displayed on the Table in Pocket Pad.



Select the Table > Press "Start Order" > Add Items > Send the Order > The Table Status changes to Ordered.



The Table Name is printed on the Kitchen Docket.

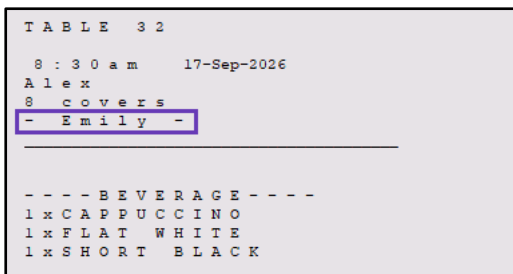

Programmable Barcodes

IP-8288 – Programmable Barcodes – Standard Search if Programmable Item not found

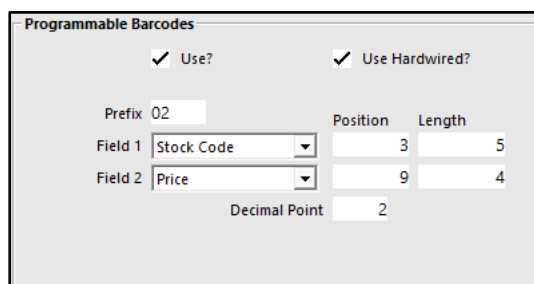
This functionality will perform a standard search if the scanned programmable barcode item is not found.

This functionality will trigger when a store has standard Scan Codes which fall in the same range as Programmable Barcodes.

Two example scenarios are outlined below that show how this works.

Scenario 1 – Programmable Barcodes option used from Global Options > Sales

The Programmable Barcodes section in Idealpos (Back Office > Setup > Global Options > Sales) is configured as follows:

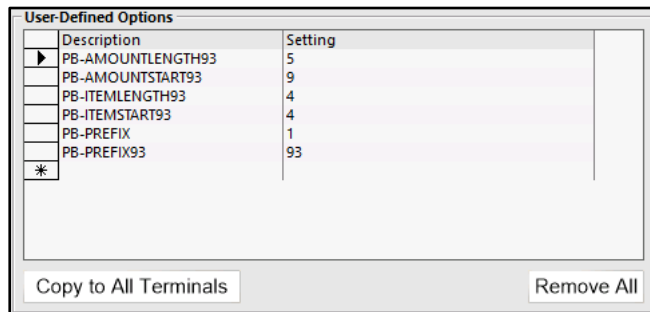

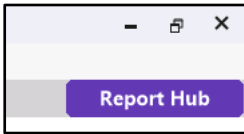

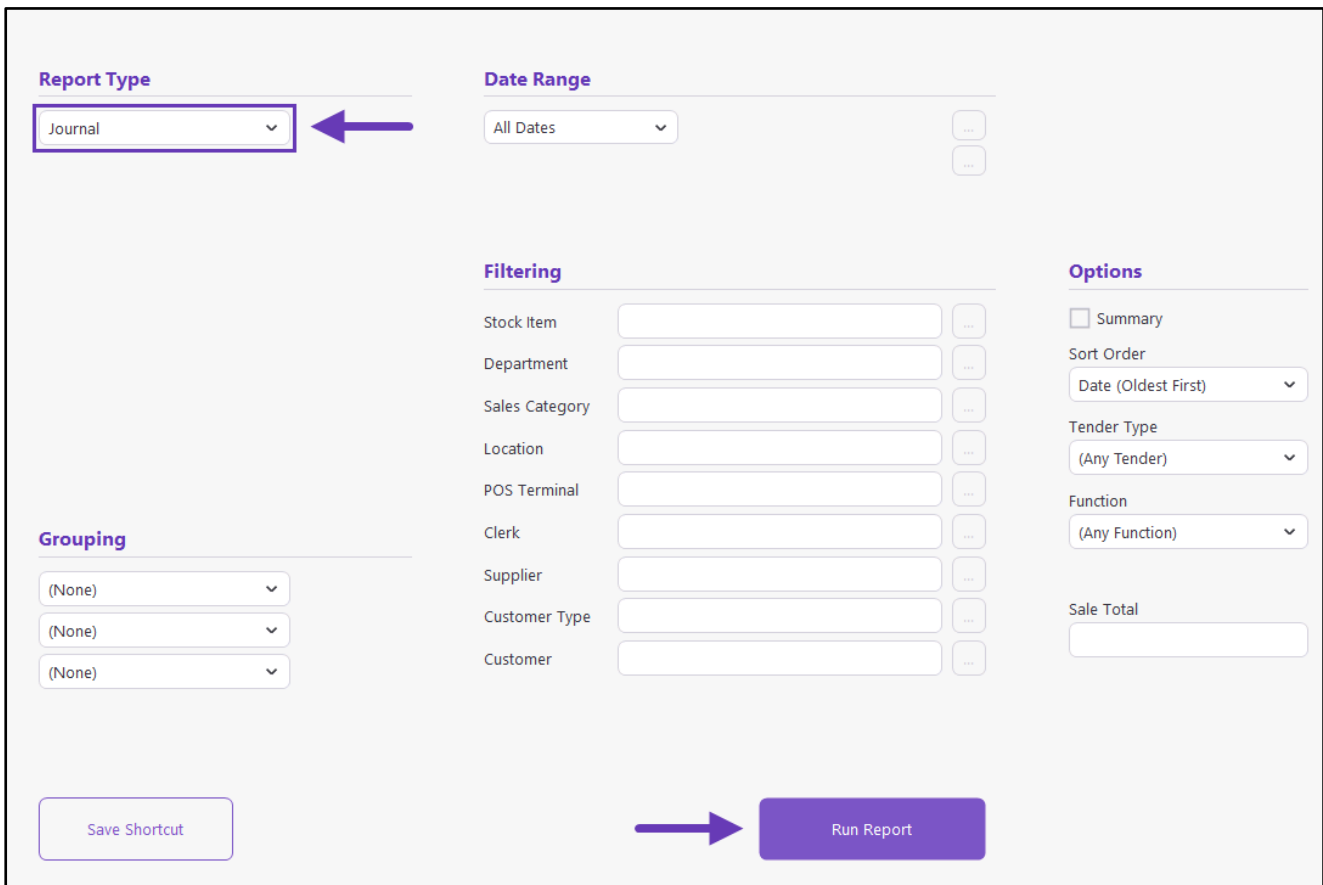
Report Hub

IP-8253 – Report Hub – New Journal Report Type Reports

This functionality adds a new "Journal" Report Type to the Report Hub.
To access and run the Journal Report Type in the Report Hub, go to:
Back Office Dashboard > Press "Report Hub" on the top-right corner.



Select "Journal" from the Report Type dropdown box, select the required selection criteria and press "Run Report".
The Filtering fields support entry of codes as single values, comma separated values, as a range or a combination.

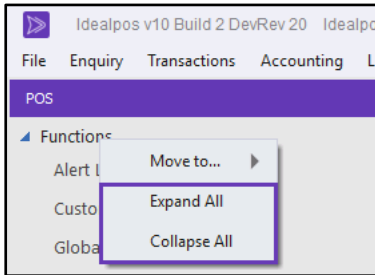

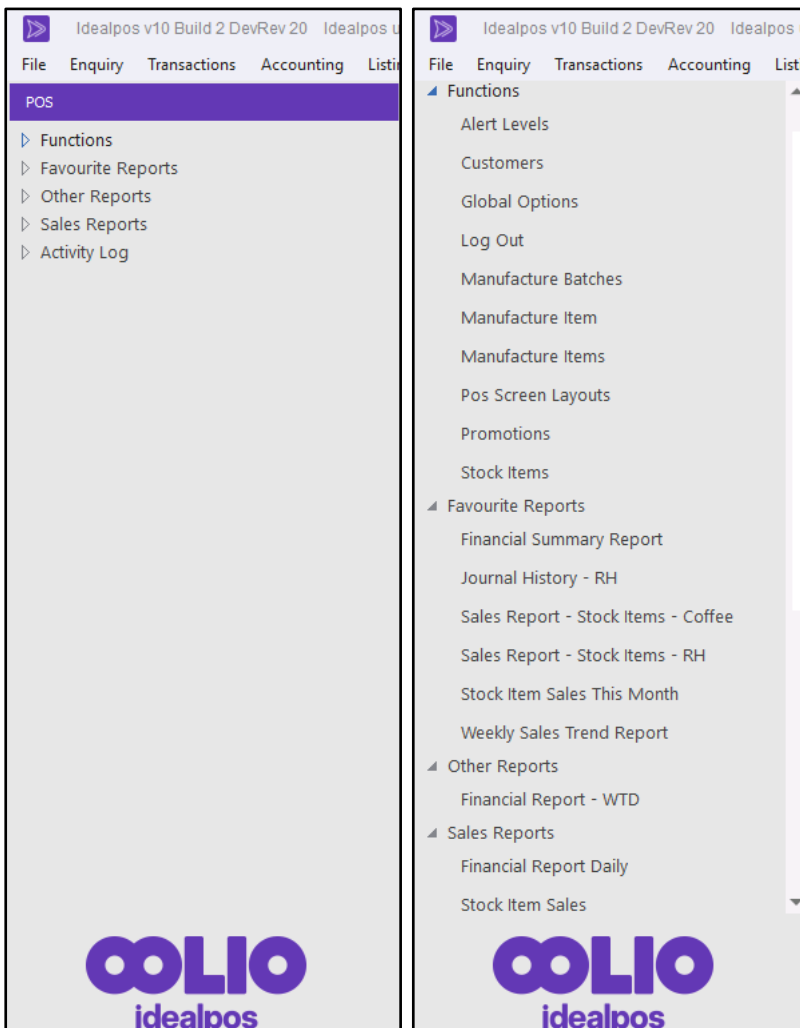

IP-8205 – Surcharges On/Off Functionality

This functionality introduces the ability to switch Surcharges On/Off via a POS Screen Function/Button with the option to password protect the button to prevent unauthorised use.

This function can be used to temporarily stop Surcharges from applying while utilising functions such as Subtotal Discounts or other scenarios that require Surcharges to be temporarily turned off.

This function will only turn Surcharges On/Off which are currently active that have been configured via Back Office > File > Sales > Surcharges.

This function will not turn off Surcharges that apply to Tender Types, nor will it turn off manual surcharges that have been triggered via the "%+ Item" or "%+ Subtotal" POS Screen buttons.

A new Yes/No Option called "Surcharges Off Function – One Sale Only" has also been added which can be toggled on/off as required.

When the Yes/No Option is enabled, the Surcharges Off Function will only apply to one sale.

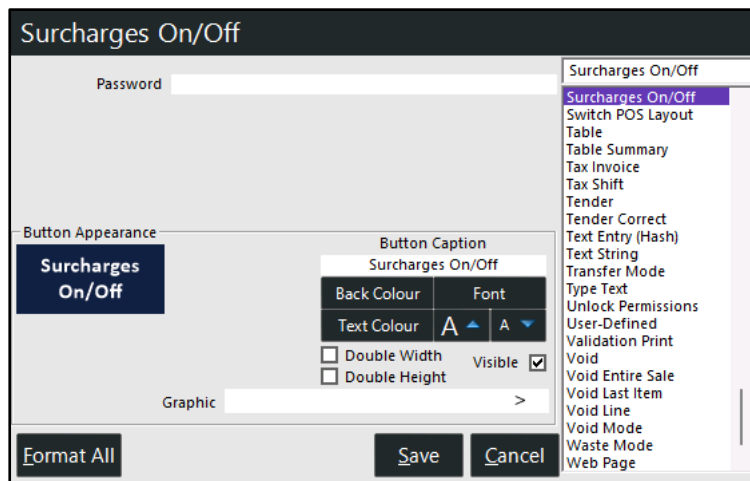
When the Yes/No Option is disabled, the Surcharges Off Function will continue to apply until it is turned off (or until the POS Screen is closed/opened or Idealpos restarted).

To configure and use this functionality, go to:

Back Office > Setup > POS Screen > POS Screen Setup > Select a POS Screen Layout > Buttons.

Configure a blank button as follows:

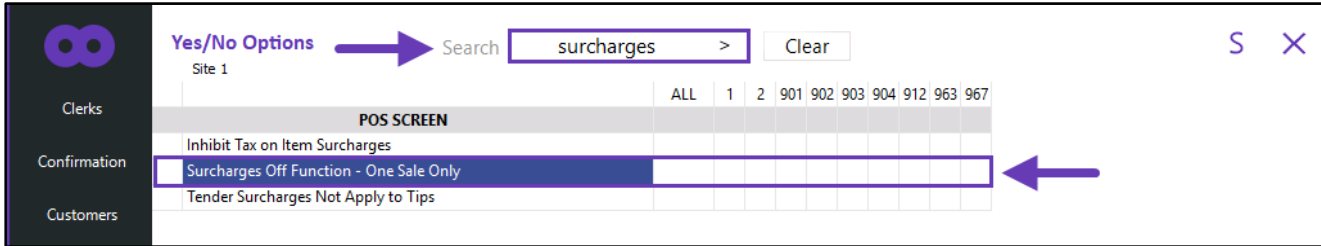
- **Function:** Surcharges On/Off

XchangeIT Lottery Interface

IP-8151 – XchangeIT Lottery Interface

This functionality introduces the ability to configure Idealpos with the XchangeIT Lottery Interface.

The XchangeIT Lottery Interface enables Idealpos to process lottery sales and lottery payments from the XchangeIT Terminal Connect service.

The below is a summary of how this interface works.

Sale of Lottery products

- The customer at the newsagency fills out lottery slip(s) with their lottery numbers and presents them to the operator.
- The operator inserts the customer's lottery slip(s) into the S8/Wave 8 Lottery Terminal.
- The S8/Wave8 Lottery Terminal prints out a slip containing a list of Lottery products that were purchased with a barcode at the bottom of the slip – the operator will scan the barcode on the slip into the Idealpos POS Terminal.
- Alternatively, the operator can press a Lottery Connect button on the Idealpos POS screen which will request the current "sessions" in the Lottery message pool; they can then select the correct session that corresponds to the customer's purchase.
- The Lottery products that were purchased will be entered into the sale.
- The sale is tendered and the customer pays for the lottery products.
- After the sale is tendered, the S8/Wave 8 Lottery Terminal will print the final lottery tickets for the operator to give to the customer.

Payout of Lottery products

- The customer presents their lottery ticket to the operator
- Operator inserts the customer's ticket into the S8/Wave 8 Lottery Terminal.
- If the ticket is a winning ticket, a Payout slip is printed from the terminal.
- Operator scans the payout slip barcode into the Idealpos POS Terminal.
- Alternatively, the operator can press the Lottery Connect button on the POS Screen which will request the current "sessions" in the Lottery message pool; they can then select the correct session that corresponds to the customer's win.
- The winning lottery item will appear in the sale as a refund.
- Sale is tendered and winnings are paid out to the customer.
